6. How would the message from the angels be "good news of great joy?"

7. From verse 11, where is "the city of David?" What is so significant with where Jesus was born? (Micah 5:2)

8. Of all the people the angels could have visited, why did God send them to the shepherds?

9. How would you describe what happened in verses 13-14? What is so significant about what the angels were saying in verse 14?

10. After the Angels left in verse 15, and the shepherds made their way to Bethlehem, what would be some of the emotions they might have been experiencing along the way? How did the Shepherds react when they finally saw the baby in verse 17 & 20?

11. What do you think it means that "Mary treasured up all these things and pondered them in her heart?"
