9. What are the implications of verses 29 and 30 concerning God's original diet for mankind?

10. On the seventh day, found in Genesis 2:1-3, what did God establish for all mankind? What should we do about it today? (Mark 2:23-28)

11. In Genesis 2:18 the first dilemma in creation was mentioned when God said "it is not good for man to be alone." How did God overcome this dilemma in a very significant and symbolic way?

12. What is beautiful about God's ordinance for marriage found in Genesis 2:18-25?
