6. How can zeal for God sometimes get in the way of knowing Him?

7. From verses 2-3 in what characteristic way did Jews seek to be right with God? (9:32) What was the basic problem in this approach? (3:20; 7:7-11)

8. From verse 4 how is it that Jesus is the "end of the law"? Based on this how should Christians approach God's law?

9. What is Paul trying to communicate in verses 5-7? What are the implications associated with "who will ascend into heaven"? Or, "who will descend into the deep"?

10. Based on the previous answer, how is Christ either brought down or raised up?

11. What is Paul's conclusion in verse 8? What are the implications of this truth for all who believe?
