Getting Started

Digging Deeper

4. What are the four “if’s” in Philippians 2:1-2? Describe ways in which you have experienced these.

5. In what area(s) of your life is it especially tough to do what we are commanded in Philippians 2:3-4? What does “have this mind among yourselves” mean in verse 5?

6. What does Mathew 11:29 say about Jesus?

7. What does “Form of God” mean in verse 6? In what ways did Jesus descend in verses 6-8?

8. Read John 1:1-4. List 3-5 things that these verses tell us about Jesus. What do Colossians 1:15 and Hebrews 1:3 each tell us about Jesus? What is the impact of this as it relates to Jesus’ humility?
