Getting Started

1. What scripture verse, word, or phrase really hit you when listening to the sermon or reading this week’s text, and why?
2. Describe an embarrassing or humbling moment in your life. Are you easily embarrassed? Do you like attention or like to go unnoticed?
3. Think of someone in your life, past or present, that is humble. What specifically makes them humble?

Digging Deeper

4. Read Philippians 2:12-30 Who are the examples of humility in this passage?

5. In verses 12-13 we are told to work out our salvation with fear and trembling. Who is to do the work and why?

6. According to verses 14-16, what is the connection between humility, the church, and the world?

7. How is the apostle Paul an example of humility (verses 16-18)?

8. What are ways that you can model (specific examples) the humility of Timothy (verses 19-24)?

9. How does Paul refer to Epaphroditus? What can we learn about Epaphroditus and his humility from this passage (verses 25-30)?

10. Compare and contrast verse 12 with verse 28. In what way do these verses relate to each other?

11. What do the following scriptures say about humility: Mathew 23:12; Psalm 138:6; Isaiah 57:15?
