Verse 5:21

- Murder is a capital offense

- Most anger against others is murder in God's eyes
- Viewing or calling people stupid morons puts us in danger of hell

Ephesians 4:26-27, Mark 3:1-6, Mark 10:14, Matthew 23:25-32, John 2 and Matthew 21


Anger against things other than people

Verse 5:22
