Believe: to know to be true. To be worthy of being trusted. Have confidence in. To have faith.

What do I believe about Jesus, and how does that effect the way I live?

John 11:1-4: The end told from the beginning

- 1. The story does not end with Lazarus dead
- 2. The son of God will get glory for what happens

John 11:5-16: The ending told a second time

Thomas has been given the spoiler twice now, and yet, the future he sees is not just Lazarus dead...but all of them dead. Apparently, Jesus is no match for the power of death...not only for Lazarus but also for the disciples, and even more, for Jesus himself.

John 11:17-27: "I am the resurrection and the life"

Jesus has the power to raise to life that which is dead.

Part of the identity of Jesus, is one who can offer the opportunity to never die

John 11:28-37 "If only you came sooner"

Everyone looked for Jesus to show his power by preventing death.

For Jesus, the glory He was after was rooted in them believing that He could bring the dead to life.

John 11:38-45 "Lazarus, come out"

The people see Lazarus come back to life, and they are receiving much more than just their friend. Much more than just their brother. Verse 45 says what they received....many that day, received belief....and in return...Jesus received Glory.
