

# WEEKLY GROUP GUIDE

Scripture: Psalm 110

Week of: August 18, 2025Message Title: The Reigning King△ Speaker: Pastor Saolomon

#### 1. ICEBREAKER (5-10 MINS)

Have you seen leadership and compassion come together? Think of a leader who both carried authority and cared deeply — what impact did they have on you?

#### 2. READ TOGETHER

Read **Psalm 110** aloud as a group.

Ask: "What stands out to you from this psalm about the kind of King Jesus is?"

# 3. GROUP DISCUSSION (30-40 MINS)

**DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:** You don't need to go through all the questions with the group. Choose the most relevant ones.

- 1. Psalm 110:1 begins with God the Father saying to the Son, "Sit at my right hand."
  - What does this tell us about Jesus' authority *right now*? How does this truth comfort or challenge you?
- 2. The psalm says Jesus rules "in the midst of his enemies" (v.2).
  - What does that mean for how we live today in a world that often opposes truth? How can we grow in faithfulness even in hostile environments?
- 3. Pastor Saolomon explained that verse 3 pictures believers freely offering themselves in service to Christ.

  What might this look like in your life right now? What holds you back from that kind of joyful surrender?

- 4. Psalm 110:4 declares that Jesus is a **priest forever** the one who intercedes for us.
  - How does this give you confidence when you struggle or feel unworthy before God? (Cf. Hebrews 4:14-16)
- 5. Verses 5–6 describe Christ as the final **judge of the nations**.
  - How do judgment and justice fit into the gospel? What difference does it make to know Jesus will one day make all things right?
- 6. This psalm paints a strong image of Jesus as both **King** and **Priest** full of power and compassion. How do you see both roles shaping your relationship with him?
- 7. In verse 7, Jesus is pictured *drinking from the brook* and *lifting up his head.*How does this image of refreshment and perseverance encourage you in your own spiritual journey?
- 8. Pastor Saolomon walked through six snapshots of King Jesus in this psalm.
  - Which one resonates most with you today Ruling Warrior, Conquering, Good, Eternal Priest, Judge of the Nations, or Victorious?
- 9. Bethel's mission is to proclaim the truth of Jesus and grow mature disciples for the glory of God.

  How does this vision challenge or encourage you personally?

  What steps could you take this week to actively live it out in your home, workplace, or friendships?
- 10. Bethel's core values include worship, Bible knowledge, fellowship, prayer, service, giving, evangelism, and missions.
  - Which of these values do you see reflected in Psalm 110 or emphasized in the sermon? How can your group grow in living out one of these values together this season?

# 4. Prayer (10-15 mins)

Encourage openness and honesty.

#### **Prompt:**

Praise Jesus as your King and Priest.

Ask for courage to submit to his rule and grace to reflect his love.

Pray for strength to serve freely and persevere faithfully this week.
